## VILLAGE OF LOON LAKE

Bylaw No. 1/95

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF LOON LAKE TO REGULATE THE TIME AFTER WHICH MINORS SHALL BE IN A PUBLIC PLACE.

The Council of the Village of Loon Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as authorized by the Urban Municipality Act, 1984, enacts as follows:

## PART 1 - INTRODUCTION

- 1. Title
  This bylaw shall be known and may be cited as the CURFEW BYLAW.
- 2. PURPOSE

  The purpose of this bylaw is to regulate the time at which minors are allowed to be in a public place without proper guardianship except for some unavoidable cause.

## PART 2 - REGULATIONS

- 3. No child under the age of sixteen years shall be in a public place in the Village of Loon Lake between the hours of 11:00 o'clock p.m. and 6:00 o'clock a.m. without proper guardianship.
- 4. A child under the age of sixteen years found in a public place after the time appointed may be warned to go home by any constable or peace officer, and if after such warning the child is found loitering in a public place the child may be taken by the constable or officer to the child's home or may be delivered to an "officer" as defined under The Child and Family Services Act. \$.S.c C-7.2.

## Part 3 - PENALTIES

- 5. Any person between the ages of 12 years and 16 years who contravenes this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties as specified in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village of Loon Lake.
- 6. Any parent, guardian, or person responsible for the custody of a minor child under the age of sixteen years who permits or allows his or her child or ward to contravene this bylaw is guilty of an offence and is liable to the penalties as specified in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village of Loon Lake.
