
BYLAW No. 2-2014

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Village of Loon Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
2. Section 3 applies only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of *The Municipality Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$10,000.00 and costs of every offence.
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of *The Municipality Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more the \$25,000.00 and costs of every offence.
5. Bylaw No. 10/86 passed October 22, 1986, is hereby repealed.
