

**VILLAGE OF LOON LAKE
BYLAW 1/2016**


A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A BASE TAX

The Council of the Village of Loon Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Base Tax Bylaw".
2. A base tax shall apply to the types and classifications of property listed as follows:
 - a. Residential Land: \$500
 - b. Residential Land & Improvements: \$500
 - c. Commercial Land: \$800
 - d. Commercial Land & Improvements: \$800
3. Where a property is classified within more than one property classification by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency, the base tax calculation shall be considered independently and applied to each classification.
4. Bylaw 4-2010 is hereby repealed.
