Policy Objective

To give authorization for residents to acquire Liquor Permits from the Sask. Liquor and Gaming

Background

1. Under the Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming regulations, any persons applying for a license to see liquor at their establishments, homes, yards, or functions thereon.
2. Anyone holding a function involved in the sale of alcohol must have the land location, data, time, and type of function.
3. The Municipality in which the property is situated must give their approval to hold such function.

Policy

1. The Council for the Village of Loon Lake authorize the Administrator to provide a letter of approval for any function within the Village of Loon Lake boundaries with the following stipulations:
 - a. That a letter of request must be completed by the applicant stating
 - i. Date and time of bar hours
 - ii. Name
 - iii. Location
 - b. That approval will be given by the Administrator on behalf of the Council; and that the "Village of Loon Lake does not accept any responsibility for any problem, accident or liability that may arise from the function."

Effective Date/Repeal

This policy will come into effect on May 5, 2022 unless otherwise specified and shall be implemented as outlined in this policy. This policy repeals and replaces all resolutions and any policies pertaining to Liquor Permits and replaces all past practices. This policy may only be amended or repealed by resolution of Council.
