### **Purpose**

To set fees to be charged for sale of snowploughing flags and conditions for snowploughing of driveway and lanes

### **Policy**

The Village of Loon Lake shall provide snow removal services to residents of the Village of loon Lake when requested. The property owner/ renter will place a “snowplough flag” up at the end of their lane or private drive.

Snowplough flags MUST be placed at the end of driveway prior to snow removal equipment going past the residence. If not the owner/renter will have to wait until the Village equipment operator is available.

Snowplough flags can be purchased at the Village Office for \$20 per flag. Snowplough flags represent a maximum of 10 minutes of service and are intended solely for service to the owner’s principal residence and adjacent buildings. If multiple flags are purchased, please phone the Village office when putting out the flag to ensure the Foreman is aware that the services is being requested.

If any snowploughing, in the opinion of the Public Works Foreman, will take longer than 10 minutes Policy 300-02 Custom Work shall apply.

Land owner / renter must sign *Snow Removal Agreement Schedule A* at time of flag purchase.

It is the responsibility of owner/renter to insure all property, animals, and persons are not where damage could occur and the Village assumes no liability for any damage caused.

### **Exception**

The Village Public Works Foreman reserves the right to refuse to snowplough driveway/lane due to availability of equipment or manpower and where conditions exist that may cause damage to the equipment or property.

### **Effective Date/Repeal**

This policy will come into effect on October 6, 2022 unless otherwise specified and shall be implemented as outlined in this policy. This policy repeals and replaces all resolutions and any policies pertaining to Snow removal for Driveway/Lanes and replaces all past practices. This policy may only be amended or repealed by resolution of Council.
