Purpose:

As per Section 55 of *The Municipalities Act Regulations* municipalities are required to submit to the Minister of Government Relations on or before September 1 of each year an Annual Waterworks Financial Overview Report.

As per Section 55 the Annual Waterworks Financial Overview Report must be made available to the public

Policy:

- Administration shall complete Schedule A "Annual Waterworks Financial Overview Report" on or before September 1 every year based on information from the previous years' financial statement.
- 2. This report must be submitted to the Minister of Government Relations electronically on or before September 1 each year.
- 3. If unable to submit electronically a copy maybe mailed to Saskatchewan Ministry of Government Relations.
- 4. Copy of Schedule to be posted to the Village of Loon Lake website if operational.
- 5. Notice to be placed on water invoices to utility users informing them that Schedule A is available at the Village Office if anyone wishes to obtain a copy.

Effective Date/Repeal

This policy will come into effect on September 1, 2021 unless otherwise specified and shall be implemented as outlined in this policy. This policy repeals and replaces all resolutions and any policies pertaining to fire bans that have been consolidated into this policy and replaces all past practices. This policy may only be amended or repealed by resolution of Council.
