Sick Leave:

Sick day shall mean time that is taken off due to an illness, injury or out of town medical appointments for the employee or employee’s immediate family

Immediate family defined in this policy shall mean employee’s spouse, parents of the spouse, parent, grandparent, child, grandchild, brother or sister.

Each full time employee is entitled to 1.0 days per month sick leave to be accumulated to a maximum of 12 days.

Entitled sick days are to be pro-rated for part-time employees (.23/week x percentage of hours worked in their normal work week).

Sick days do not accumulate during layoffs for seasonal employees.

Sick days do not accumulate if employee is on extended sick leave (more than 5 days)

Sick days are not vacation days or entitled days off and only can be used as defined in this policy.

The employee will be entitled to pay equivalent to their regular daily wages up to the following maximum of the hours providing they have accumulated enough sick days.

- Public Works staff 8.0 hours per day

Sick days will not be paid out should an employee quit, retire or be dismissed.

Effective Date/Repeal

This policy will come into effect on April 7, 2021 unless otherwise specified and shall be implemented as outlined in this policy. This policy repeals and replaces all resolutions and any policies pertaining to sick leave that have been consolidated into this policy and replaces all past practices. This policy may only be amended or repealed by resolution of Council.
